OUR PAST

Over the past 21 years, we have become one of the most successful and best run festivals in Bath: showing a rich programme of previews, documentaries, shorts, animations, silent films with live music, workshops, Q&A sessions and one off events.

We've brought over 1,000 great films to Bath, from Hollywood headliners to the best of children's animation.

Last year we screened the Oscar-winning *The King's Speech* 3 months before its release; introduced the art-house hit *Of Gods and Men*; and previewed the infamous *Catfish* at Walcot Reclamation.

OUR PRESENT

Some highlights for the 2011 festival, 10th -19th Nov include:

Our patron, *Ken Loach*, is 75 this year. We'll be celebrating with the man himself and some of his most interesting films.

Local Chippenham film, *Bash Street* with Q&A from the director and cast in association with Jamie's Farm. Based in Box, they help inner city kids.

Cult 80s film (re-released) *Cutter's Way*, with a young – and oh so gorgeous! – Jeff Bridges.

A whole host of previews and one off events.

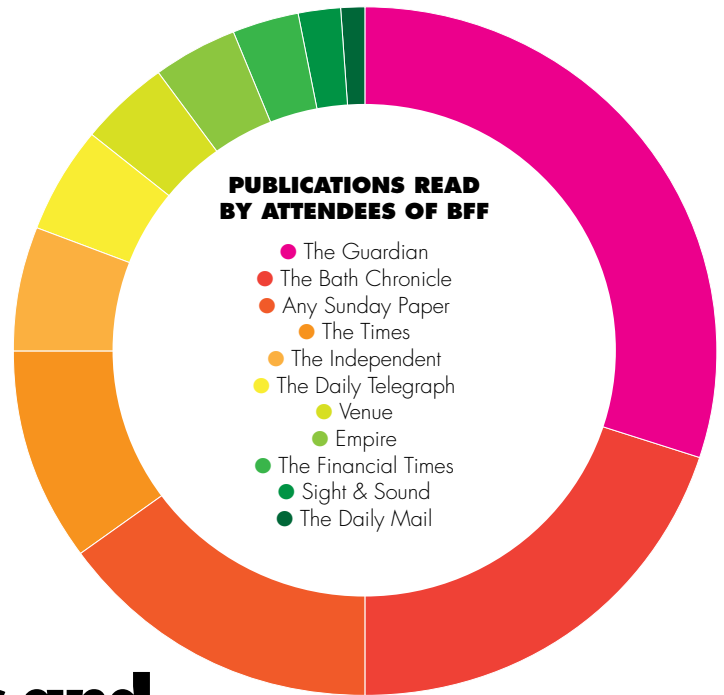
OUR FUTURE

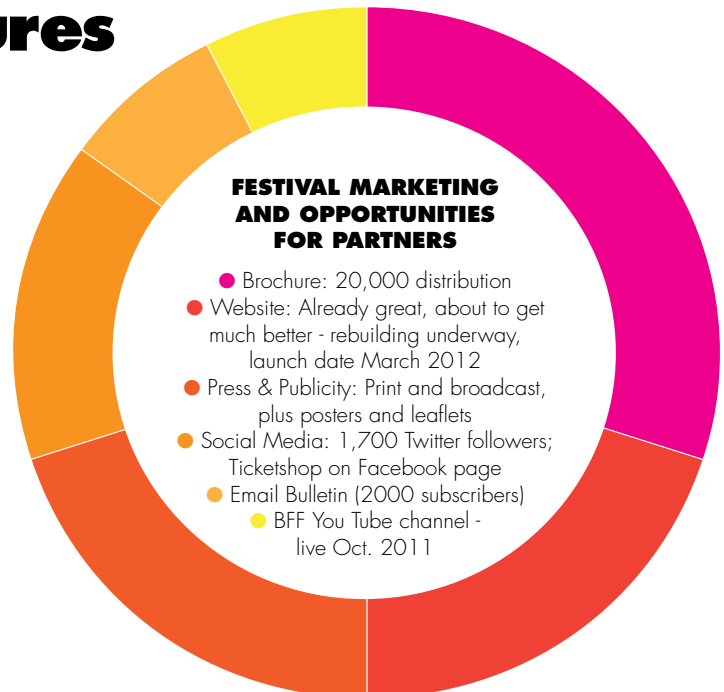
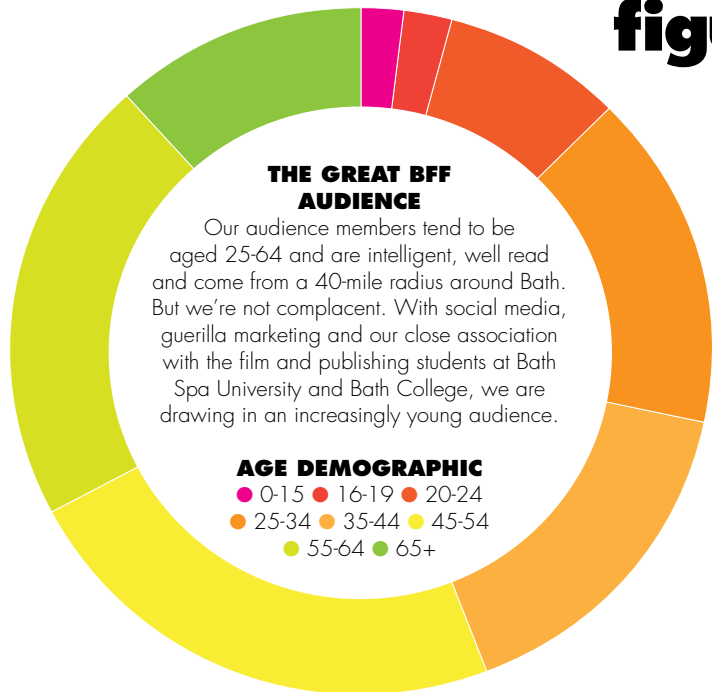
